ECO-COLLAGE



PIECING TOGETHER A GREENER TOMORROW



PARTICIPATION:

Individual entries only

TIME DURATION:

30 minutes + 10 minutes buffer

THEME:

The collage must creatively and clearly convey the theme of plastic pollution awareness, environmental sustainability, eco-conscious living.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Creativity & Innovation
- Relevance to Theme
- Composition & Neatness
- Message & Interpretation
- Effort & Presentation

MATERIALS GUIDELINES:

- Participants must bring their own materials: old newspapers, magazines, scissors, glue, paper cuttings, colored papers.
- A3 size sheet will be provided by the organizers as the base for the collage.
- Use of non-recyclable, plastic-based, or pre-designed art templates is strictly prohibited.
- No digital printouts, pre-cut ready-made pieces not allowed.

BOTTLE BEAUTY



COLOR THE WASTE, CRAFT THE CHANGE

PARTICIPATION TYPE:

Individual

TIME LIMIT:

30 minutes + 10 minutes buffer

ARTWORK GUIDELINES:

- Any form of pre-made art on the bottle (stickers, print, etc.) is not permitted.
- Only external surface of the bottle is to be painted.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Creativity and Innovation
- Relevance to the theme
- Visual appeal
- Technique and execution
- Clarity of eco-friendly message

MATERIALS SPECIFICATION:

- Participants must bring their own used plastic or glass bottle (cleaned and dry).
- Only waste or discarded bottles are allowed – no brand new or pre-painted bottles.
- All painting materials (colors, brushes, palette, etc.) must be brought by the participant.

TRASH TO TREASURE



TRANSFORM WASTE INTO WONDER



PARTICIPATION TYPE:

Individual or Team (maximum 2 members)

TIME LIMIT:

Participants will be given 60 minutes to complete their model.

MATERIALS ALLOWED:

- Only waste or discarded items should be used.
- Items like plastic bottles, cans, old newspapers, wrappers, cardboard, broken electronics, etc., are encouraged.
- Use of new, store-bought materials will lead to disqualification.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Creativity and innovation
- Relevance to theme
- Effective use of waste materials
- Functionality or practical value
- Overall presentation

MATERIALS SPECIFICATION:

- Participants must bring their own tools, glue, scissors, colors, etc.
- No materials will be provided by the organizers.
- Each participant/team will be given 2-3 minutes to explain their creation to the panel of judges.
- The model must reflect the theme.

LANGUAGE:

English (Text must be readable and clear)

POSTER SPECIFICATIONS:

- Only digital posters are accepted
- Size: A2 (Digital dimension equivalent)
- Format: PDF
- File Name: CollegeName_StudentName_PosterTitle
- Last date for poster submission: 2nd June, 2025

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Creativity and innovation
- Relevance to theme
- Clarity and effectiveness of message
- Visual impact and aesthetics
- Originality of design and content

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- All posters must creatively reflect the theme: "Ending Global Plastic Pollution – Combusting Plastic Pollution"
- Selected posters will be featured on the official university platforms.
- Posters must be original and self-created. Plagiarism or use of AI-generated content will lead to rejection.

MODE OF COMPETITION:

Online

LANGUAGE:

English (if dialogues are included, subtitles recommend if in local language)

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Each reel must be 30 to 60 seconds in duration.
- The reel may be informative, inspirational, or awareness-based.
- Reel must align with the theme: "Combusting Plastic Pollution - Youth and Environmental Responsibility"

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Relevance to the theme
- Originality and creativity
- Clarity and impact of message
- Technical presentation
- Social media engagement

SUBMISSION DETAILS:

- Last date for reel submission: 2nd June, 2025
- Register via Google Form and Send the Reel via Telegram
- Format: MP4
- Filename: CollegeName_StudentName_ReelTitle
- Ensure good video and audio clarity
- Selected posters will be featured on the official university platforms.
