CIA Planning & Preparation

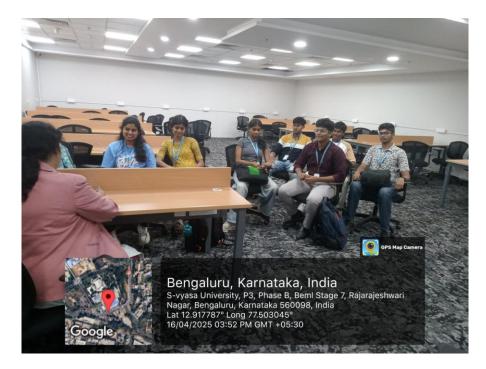
