Organized by: Allied and Health Care Department in association with NSS Team

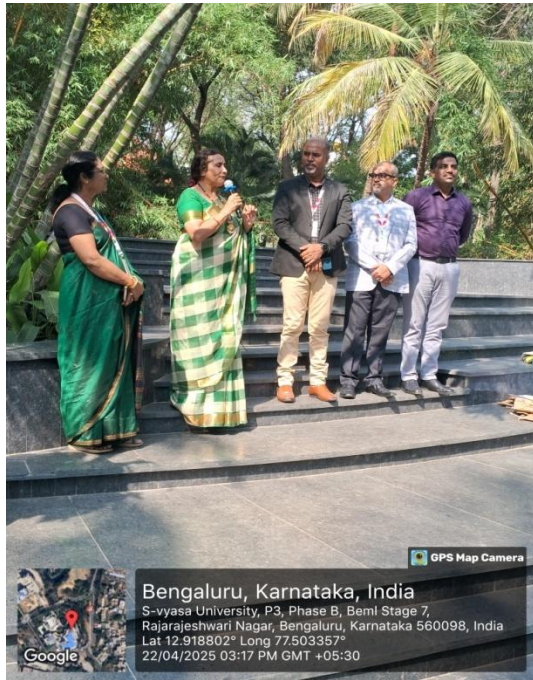
