### Notification

SVYASA Society is offering a “Special Program for Examination and Certification (SPEC)” in four levels Pravesha, Parichaya, Praudha and Kovida in the fields of Music (Karnataka Sangita, Laghu Sangita), Dance (Bharatanatyam, Kuchipudi, Kathak) and Instruments (Flute, Veena, Violin).

**Registration is open for Students** who wish to apply for “SPEC” in four levels Pravesha, Parichaya, Praudha and Kovida on Music, Dance, and Instruments to be held in June/July 2025

#### **Age Criteria to apply for exams**

- Three years of gap between Level 1 to level 2 (2025 -2028)
- Three years of gap between Level 2 to level 3 (2028 - 2030)
- One year gap between Level 3 (2030) to level 4 (2031)

#### **Level 1 - Pravesha exam**

- Age of the student should be 10 years (From 1.1.2015 to 1.6.2025)
- Should have at least two years of training

To attach:

- Study certificate
- Training certificate from the teacher or institution.

#### **Level 2 - Parichaya exam**

- Three years of gap between Level 1 to level 2
- If appearing directly to Level 2, they should complete 15 years of age

To attach:

- Birth certificate and SSLC marks card
- Training certificate from the teacher or institution.

#### **Level 3 - Praudha exam**

- Three years of gap between Level 2 to level 3

- If appearing directly to Level 3, they should complete 18 years of age
- Eight years of training in respective field

To attach:

- Birth certificate and PUC or Diploma marks card
- Training certificate from the teacher or institution.

#### **Level 4 - Kovida exam**

- One year gap between Level 3 to level 4
- If appearing directly to Level 4, they should complete 20 years of age
- Ten years of training in respective field

To attach:

- Birth certificate and Bachelor degree Convocation certificate
- Training certificate from the teacher or institution.

➤ **Candidates can appear for only one exam in one year.**

#### **Fee payment:**

Payment is only through Debit card/ Credit card/Net banking/ UPI transaction. Cheque/DD/Challan payments are not accepted.

#### **Instructions**

**Candidate should apply only through SVYASA registered teacher or institution mentioning their assigned code.**

2. **Mandatory Documents to be attached by the candidates:**

- a. Passport size photo
- b. Aadhar card
- c. Birth Certificate/SSLC marks card/ TC/ Study certificate
- d. Special category (Caste) certificate (if applicable)
- e. Physically challenged certificate (if applicable)

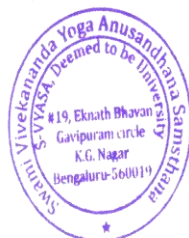
### Details of dates for the Fees payment

### Clauses to be followed by candidates

1. Application will not be accepted after the last date
2. **If the number of candidates are very less in a centre, then the candidates from that centre will be shifted to the nearest exam centre.**
3. Parents are not allowed to the exam center premises during Theory and Practical exams.
4. Candidates should attend the practical exams in a simple traditional attire. Heavy jewelry and heavy costumes are not allowed.
5. Candidates should come half an hour earlier to their time allotted for practical exams.
6. List of Practical exams will be announced on the website. Accordingly, they should appear for the exam. No changes will be made for the date and exam centre. If the candidate fails to appear for a given date, it will be marked as absent.
7. The time duration of Practical exams will work from 8am to 6pm inclusive of lunch break
8. Entry is prohibited for the non-registered teachers and examiners.
9. Dance candidates should select the exam centre for practical as guided by their teacher.
10. Both Theory and Practical will happen at the same centre for Music candidates,
11. No changes will be made once the exam centre is selected.
