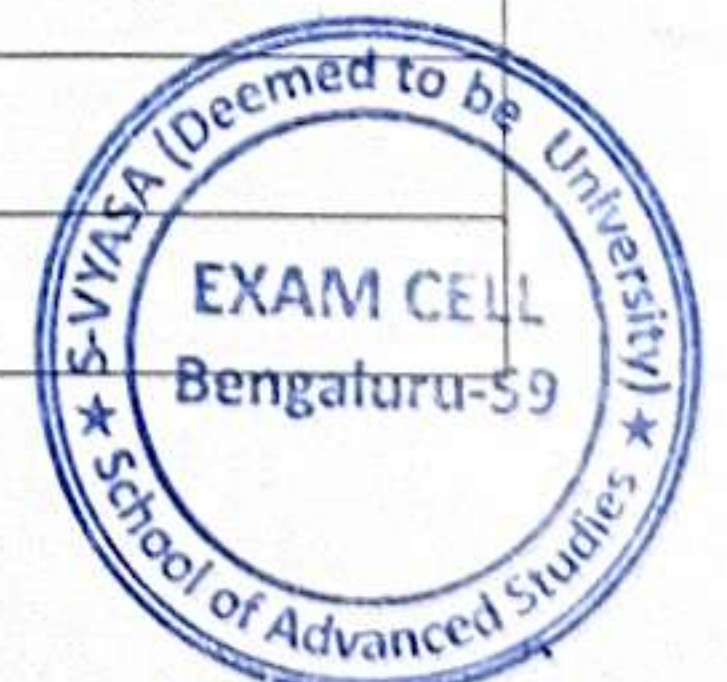

## INSTRCUTIONS TO STUDENTS ON MALPRACTICE

The following listed activities will be considered as malpractice and will attract penalties.

Sl. No.	Nature of Malpractice
1	Appeal by the candidate in the answer script to show mercy by way of awarding more than deserving marks.
2	The candidate writing his/her name in the answer script.
3	The candidate writing his/her USN and/or name in places other than specified in the answer script.
4	Any special marking in the answer script by the candidate.
5	The candidate communicating with neighboring candidate orally or non-verbally; the candidate showing suspicious movement of his/her body.
6	Irrelevant writing by the candidate in the answer script.
7	The Candidate writing answer on his/her question paper or making use of his/her question paper.
8	The candidate possessing cell phone(s)/programmable calculator(s)/any other electronic storage device(s) and containing incriminating materials (whether used or not).
9	The candidate facilitating the other candidate(s) to copy from his/her answer script.
10	The candidate possessing any incriminating material(s) (whether used or not). For example:-Written or printed materials, bits of papers containing written information, writings on scale, calculator, handkerchief, dress, part of the body, Hall Ticket etc.
11	The candidate possessing the question paper of another candidate with additional writing on it.
12	The candidate passing his/her question paper to another candidate with additional writing on it
13	The candidate passing incriminating materials brought into the examination hall in any medium (hard/soft) to other candidate(s).
14	The candidate copying from neighboring candidate.
15	The candidate taking out of the examination hall answer booklet(s). used or unused.
16	Appeal by the candidate in the answer script coupled with a promise of any form of consideration.
17	Candidate destroying evidence relating to an alleged irregularity.
18	Vulgar / offensive writings by the candidate in the answer script.
19	The candidate possessing the answer script of another candidate.
20	The Candidate passing his/her answer script to another candidate.
21	The candidate substituting an answer booklet prepared outside the examination hall for the one already distributed to the candidate.
22	The candidate misbehaving in the examination hall.
23	Cases of impersonation.
24	Tampering of Barcode pasted on the answer booklet.




The Unfair Means and Malpractices Committee (UMMC) may recommend one or more of the following pan penalties (briefly listed) to be imposed on students(s) declared guilty of using Unfair Means and Malpractices.

➤ **For Semester End Examinations:**

- ✓ Registration of the course(s) concerned is cancelled and "RC" grade awarded
- ✓ Rustication for one (01) Semester/Academic Year
- ✓ Expulsion from the University
- ✓ Handing over the case to the Police if it is found that a criminal offence is involved; and/or
- ✓ Any other action as deemed fit by the UMMC.

➤ **For Internal Assessment:**

- ✓ Zero (0) marks is given in the concerned component of assessment; and/or,
- ✓ Impose a condition that the student(s) guilty of using unfair means shall not be awarded a grade higher than "**C**" grade in the concerned Course, irrespective of the overall performance of the concerned student(s).
